Pastor's Note

For there is no distinction, since all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God; they are now justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ lesus.

(Romans 3:22b-24, NRSV)

Dear Friends in Christ,

This month, as I write to you, I must apologize. I made a mistake last month and provided you with some inaccurate information. You might recall that I said something was happening this year that hasn't happened since 1945, that Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day fell on the same day. This is not true. The last time this happened was actually just in 2018. Prior to that it was 1945. This serves as a reminder for me that I need to pay closer attention to the dates that articles were written.

In the grand scheme of things, this may not be that big of a deal. This was a rather minor mistake, and I have certainly made worse mistakes, but it was a mistake regardless. As I thought about this it seemed so appropriate that it would at this time. We were talking about Ash Wednesday and the beginning of lent. A season of the church where we are typically a little more introspective, considering and confessing our sins, and acknowledging our mortality. All of this reminded me of the words from Paul to the Romans.

We all make mistakes, we all sin. We fall short of the glory of God. Left on our own we would be in trouble, but we aren't left on our own. God who loves us, also graciously justifies us. Through the redemption in Christ, God brings us back to a right relationship and reveals to us a new life found only in Christ.

2024 LENTEN CONGREGATIONAL PROJECT CAMP LUTHERLYN "BUILDING for the FUTURE" CAPTIAL CAMPAIGN

Since 1948, Lutherlyn has become an influential presence in the lives of youth and adults throughout Western Pennsylvania. Borne from the conviction that youth would benefit from a faith-based leadership camp, Lutherlyn has intentionally expanded to include education opportunities that explore God's creation. The impact of Lutherlyn lives on in generations of campers, retreaters, summer staff, and the communities of which they are a part.

This \$2.5 million campaign will add 5 new winterized cabins, repair the amphitheater, remove old cabins, improve roads, and add 5 seasonal cabins. The *Building for the Future* capital campaign will provide the funding necessary to retain Lutherlyn's capacity for year-round programs and increase the number of youths, adults, and congregations served by this ministry for generations to come. NOISY OFFERING FOR MARCH

For March and April's Noisy Offering, we will be collecting for Street Outreach organized by Seton Hill University's School of Physical Therapy. The group hopes to meet the needs of and provide medical care to individuals who are unhoused or experiencing rough sleeping. Currently they only consist of physical therapists and other non-clinicians, but as they assess the needs of the community, they plan to reach out to other medical providers to ask them to participate as well. They are modeling themselves after Street Medicine which was founded in Pittsburgh over 30 years ago. It is now an international community of providers but its roots started in Western PA and we would like to expand the outreach in our region beyond Pittsburgh.
